Background: The AATFA Youth Festival is in the process of significantly increasing marketing and communication activities for its event under the direction of the National AATFA Committee.

These initiatives will usually involve images of students being utilised in all forms of media, including newspapers, radio, television and the Internet. Common methods of publication may likely include brochures, newspaper, radio and television advertisements, promotional videos and school websites.

In addition, the AATFA Youth Festival may attract widespread interest from media organisations for news and current affairs stories and for lifestyle programs. To ensure consistency with our organisation's privacy principles and in keeping with applicable child protection legislation, it is a requirement for a parent or guardian of a student to give approval for their child to participate in such activities.

Consent: Consent should be provided by a parent or guardian of the student. In matters of parental or guardian dispute, the consent should be given by the parent exercising major responsibility for the student and/or the enrolling parent/guardian.

The consent form will be placed on the student's file or record and retained by AATFA Youth Festival. If requested, a copy of the form will be made available to a parent/guardian of the student.

The period of consent is valid for the length of time the child is a student participating in the AATFA Youth Festival. Once consent has been provided, written correspondence is required from an authorised consent giver before revocation of consent is recognised.

Media Access: AATFA Youth Festival through the responsibility of the National AATFA Committee has the right to refuse media access where, in the opinion of AATFA authorities, it would interfere with the student's wellbeing or negatively impact on the operation of the AATFA Youth Festival.

Copyright: At all times ownership of any material obtained from the above activities will vest with AATFA Youth Festival.
